OTHER STRONG POINTS OF DRÔME

Ideally located, the Drôme is at the crossroads of major national and European axes.

There are several cruise and cargo ports along the Rhône in the Drôme, providing the logistics industry with many development opportunities.

The Drôme is home to several hubs and clusters such as the Nuclear Valley, the only competitive hub dedicated to civil nuclear power in France, CIMES focused on the industry of the future, or even Vegepolys Valley and Innov'Alliance for agri-food. Ecotox, located in the Rovaltain centre of excellence and innovation, is a scientific platform for research in ecotoxicology and environmental toxicology which is unique in Europe. It is equipped with testing hallsand an analytical platform aimed at manufacturers and laboratories specialising in the assessment of potential risks from chemical and biological contaminants.

There are also major skills in filmmaking within a comprehensive ecosystem located in the Drôme department. This ecosystem comprises businesses, renowned training courses, such as La Poudrière and other popular events such as the Festival International des Scénaristes et Compositeurs (Screenwriters and Composers International Festival) in Valence.

The Drôme department is a world leader in the production and processing of plants (fragrances, aromatics and medicinal products) and more generally in the field of bio-cosmetics, health and well-being.

THE LUXURY INDUSTRY

The Drôme department is historically skilled in the luxury industry (Jacquard, Footwear, Leather Goods, etc.).

Many companies located in this department operate in several areas: knitting, weaving, jewellery, other activities.

More than 1,500 jobs are located in the department, with training centres part of large groups and recognised expertise, such as in Romans-sur-Isère, capital of footwear.














