OTHER STRONG POINTS OF ISÈRE

The Grenoble metropolis is renowned for its higher education-research-industry triad.

Research employs 25,000 people of which 23,000 within 20 kms of Grenoble. Major public and private research laboratories are located near Grenoble, such as CEA-Leti, INRIA, Orange, Apple, Schneider Electric, Huawei, Atos, Air Liquide, Naver Labs, STMicroelectronics, Soitec, Constellium, GE, Fujitsu, BD, etc.

The electronic components and digital sector has a real asset with a comprehensive value chain located in Isère: Electronic CAD & design, equipment & material, industry & fabless, microsystem & MEMS.

Imagers located in the department also bring cutting-edge skills. Medical technologies are also benefiting from various developments in component miniaturisation as well as in software aspects and image analysis. This ecosystem has also allowed the emergence of a centre of expertise on artificial intelligence.

The chemistry, environment and cleantech industry is made up of 400 companies, approximately 50 start-ups and cutting-edge research centres, as well as three chemical platforms considered to be models in terms of industrial ecology.

The presence of Axelera, the only French competitive hub in chemistry-environment is a real asset for the department as is the multimodal platform (water, rail, road) of Roches-Roussillon/INSPIRA with a manager of shared services and infrastructure.

VARIED AND DYNAMIC RESEARCH

- Grenoble has a very high R&D job density (1st metropolitan city in France with regards to R&D employment),
- Grenoble Alpes is the 2nd French site with the most ERC Consolidator Grant winners and CNRS and IUF medal holders),
- In 2019: 401 patent applications submitted to the INPI, i.e. 24.67% of applications in the Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes region. An interesting 17% increase in 2019,
- Many recognised research centres: CEA-Leti, LITEN, INRIA, 5 international scientific instruments (ESRF, ILL, IRAM, EMBL, EMFL).



DID YOU KNOW?

Isère is a pioneering department for computer-assisted medical procedures (CAMP).

Grenoble is home to five major international public research instruments: ESRF (European Synchrotron Radiation Facility), ILL (Institut Laue-Langevin), EMBL (European Molecular Biology Laboratory), EMFL (European Magnetic Field Laboratory), and IRAM (Institut de radioastronomie millimétrique).



THE MOUNTAIN SECTOR

With its companies renowned throughout the world, its flourishing ecosystem and its dynamic innovation, the department of Isère is ideal for the development of the mountain sector. It employs close to 5,600 people in the sector, of which 2,100 in the mountain development sector and 3,500 in the sports industry. The department also has living labs for innovative sports projects such as the Station de Trail in the Chartreuse or the Biz Lab from the Grenoble Ecole de Management.




BEST LOCATIONS TO SET UP YOUR BUSINESS



ROUSSILLON CHEMICAL PLATFORM OF ROCHES-ROUSSILLON


